Selene Giupponi

Selene Giupponi was one of the first women in Italy to work in Digital Forensics and Cyber Intelligence. She graduated in Computer Engineering from La Sapienza University in Rome, while already working on Digital and Mobile Forensics and counter cybercrime investigations. In the same year,



she earned a Master's in Computer Forensics & Digital Investigations from the Postal and Communications Police, in collaboration with the University of Camerino. Selene is a consultant and expert witness in international court cases and arbitrations involving Cyber Forensics (Cyber Espionage, Insider Threat). She is a speaker at various Cyber Security conferences globally and a lecturer at universities in Italy and abroad, including for Law Enforcement and Ministries of Defense. She was a Founding Member of ECSO (European Cyber Security Organization).

Currently, Selene is Managing Director for Europe at Resecurity Inc., an American company specializing in undercover DarkWeb investigations. She has been a Founding Member and Secretary General of Women4Cyber ITALY since December 2020 and a Council Member of the W4C Foundation (Brussels). She also joined the Scientific Committee of the Hermes European Study Center in March 2024.
