How AI could go beyond hallucinations and illusions

Generative AI is pervading every day life where its hallucinations are not always desirable. Similarly, even the latest variations of Large Language Models only give the 'illusion of thinking'. But there are alternative Al approaches, such as Google's AlphaEvolve, that could offer more promising approaches to general Al. Hence, this talk explores how evolving intelligence could scale to complex problems, be adept at abstracting useful concepts and explain learnt reasoning
